

So, we were just wondering...

What does an Illustrator do all day?

Working as an illustrator is the best job – I get paid to draw and colour-in all day. It never seems like work because it's too much fun. I've been a full-time professional artist for about 12 years, but I've always been an artist. I grew up in an arty family. I was always encouraged to read and to draw when I wanted to, which was most of the time.



After school, I studied for a degree in Printmaking at the Edinburgh College of Art in Scotland. Years later, I went back to study for a Master's degree in Visual Communication (Illustration). It took me a while to find my way into Australian publishing, but I was lucky enough to win an illustration award with SCBWI and Penguin Random House, and started illustrating with Affirm (By the Billabong, by Maura Finn (Affirm Press).

I love illustrating. When publishers give me a story typed on paper, it's my job to read it and start creating pictures of a whole new set of characters and their worlds. I usually see images forming in my head straight away. Imagination begins.


My favourite part of illustrating a book, is creating the characters.

They are **usually based on people that I know**. sometimes including references to their personalities such as a lively nana [my friend, Cher, from the gym] or a silly old grandpa with a moustache [my grandad, Reg].

Most of the books I've illustrated have been about native Australian animals and environments. Luckily, I live in a beautiful part of Sydney surrounded by trees and wildlife, ocean and beaches, so whatever I need to draw for my work is usually on my doorstep.

Sometimes, I need to research animals because I'm not always familiar with the unique and wonderful Australian wildlife. I learn something with every book I work on. It never gets boring.

I like to take photos and work from them in my studio, as well as **drawing** things that I make up in my head.



I'm currently working on a book about broccoli, one about birds, and a possible author/illustrator title that's top secret at the moment. I'm also working my way through a screen-printed alphabet (currently I'm at the letter **H** so I have a long way to go).

Finding time to read is vital in sharpening my imagination so I can create worlds that readers want to keep visiting. I hope you can see the love and humour that I put into my illustrations. If you have very good eye-sight, you might also see a couple of **hidden mice** and sausage dogs.

If you want to illustrate picture books: Never stop drawing. Draw all the time. Draw everything!




(hmmm- and who actually created Morrie?



My "go-to" word or wish for 2025: "GOODIES". Let us feel good enough to bring in the goodies for our creativity and ourselves. -Apsara Baldivino


