
Sami Bayly


Illustrator and Author






Jess Black is an award-winning children's author of over fifty children's books. Jess has written picture books, junior fiction and middle grade level fiction.





Jenny Blackford


Author




Zoë Disher


Jenni Goodman






Jade is the illustrator of the 10 book series, *Little Ash*. As well as working with HarperCollins, Jade also has illustration contracts





Deborah Kelly







Kirrili Lonergan





Suzanne Manson





Leila Rudge


Author/Illustrator







Paul Russell






Paula Stevenson





